- ♣ The greatest threat to trusting God is our own understanding—how we see things or how we've experienced life before. Once "our" mind starts to process and determine our steps, we get distracted, taking exits and wandering down detours. Troy E. Schmidt
- ♣ Trust is a step-by-step process of submission, following the straightest path to the destination God has determined for us. Trust God's promises to take you where you need to go. - Troy E. Schmidt

- Rest in God's promises. Resting in God's promises is the next step in trusting God's promises. The opposite of rest is worry. Worry does not add a single hour to our lives. In fact, it subtracts hours from our lives. Troy E. Schmidt
- ♣ When information about God's promises enters our minds, we hear it and understand it. However, we must then apply the truths of those promises to our hearts. Troy E. Schmidt
- We must keep at bay the notion of wanting to process our needs over and over in our minds to figure out our own solutions. Troy E. Schmidt

- ♣ In the desert, you really do learn to treasure the life that is in Christ, because it's very real, and He is very powerful. Nancy Leigh DeMoss
- ♣ God sends us into the desert to teach us. He sends us into the desert to strengthen our faith and to make us dependent on Him. Nancy Leigh DeMoss
- ♣ You'll never know that Christ is all you need, really, until He's all you have. And when He is all that you have, you will find out that Christ really is all that you need. Nancy Leigh DeMoss
- ♣ We tend to rely on things and people that we can see. God wants to teach us to depend on what we cannot see. That's faith: to rely on His character, His Word. Nancy Leigh DeMoss
- ♣ So when you can't hear, when you can't see, when you don't know—when you can't see the outcome and you feel like you're in this blind, dark night of the soul, this desert experience, with no end in sight—what do you do? You walk by faith. Nancy Leigh DeMoss

- ♣ There is a difference between immediately responding to God's invitation, doing whatever He asks, and contemplating, considering, and hesitating. Kerry Skinner

- ♣ As long as you have trouble doing the things you know you ought to do, you will not be walking in the Spirit. Resistance to Christ's commands will weaken your spirit. – Kerry Skinner
- Obedience requires the daily practice of continuing in God's Word, praying, sharing your faith, and spending time with other believers. Kerry Skinner
- ♣ Jesus said, "If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever..." (John 14:15-16).
- As you obey Christ, the Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth-not some of the truth. Kerry Skinner
- Oswald Chambers said, "There are some questions God cannot answer until you've been brought by obedience to be able to stand the answer."
- ♣ God will not break through and overpower your will to force you to obey. If you do not obey the last thing He told you to do, you will not make any progress in your Christian growth. Kerry Skinner

- ♣ Remember, even if it doesn't make sense to us, it makes sense to our God. After all, He is the author of this life, and "His thoughts are higher than our thoughts, and His ways are higher than ours." (Isaiah 55:8-9) Alisha Headley
- ↓ Let's allow God to take us to our next step as we choose to no longer disobey Him with delays or hesitated obedience. Let's instead make the choice to walk in wholehearted allegiance to God, one simple step of obedience at a time. – Alisha Headley

- ♣ As a pillar of cloud in the day and fire by night, He guided them, giving them shade from the fierceness of the desert sun, and a light in the darkest of nights. Debbie McDaniel
- God will not leave us to fend for ourselves, struggling to find our way. He will lead us. He promises to be faithful. We have his Word, and the Holy Spirit to give guidance to our days. – Debbie McDaniel
- ♣ He is with us, he gives wisdom, he provides direction, so we never have to fear being left on our own to figure things out. — Debbie McDaniel
- ♣ He goes ahead of us, he walks with us, and he guards our way against behind. His Word gives truth and life, it shows us the way to walk in this world. Debbie McDaniel

- ♣ We may feel forgotten and left on our own, but God is always with us. Debbie McDaniel
- ♣ God's presence is powerful and strong. It is never dependent on how good we are, he is faithful even in our hardest struggles. Debbie McDaniel

- ♣ In whatever you're facing, be assured, God is with you, he's providing for your needs, he has a plan, and nothing is too difficult for him. Debbie McDaniel
- ♣ The God of miracles fights for you today, and he will never let you go. Debbie McDaniel
- When we turn our faces to Christ in the midst of pain and impossibility, Christlike character is formed within us. – Candice Simmons
- ♣ Many are facing right now a wilderness or desert journey. The question most people have when they're led into a desert experience is why? But take heart; God will use our experiences here to cause this desert season to blossom like a rose. Candice Simmons
- ♣ For in the desert the Father speaks and awakens our hearts to hear. In fact, the word for "desert" in Hebrew means "the place of speaking." Candice Simmons
- ♣ The same God that can handle the Red Sea can handle deserts and drought. He can take the bitter waters of Marah and make them sweet. Candice Simmons
- ♣ And now we have run into his heart to hide ourselves in his faithfulness. This is where we find his strength and comfort. Candice Simmons
- He empowers us to seize what has already been established ahead of time—an unshakable hope! We have this certain hope like a strong, unbreakable anchor holding our souls to God himself. – Candice Simmons
- God is asking for you to believe that he's your healer and your redeemer, and that he's awakening your heart during this difficult season to trust his love for you. May your heart be awakened! Candice Simmons

- ♣ Your life, your hope, and your joy are not hidden away in some elusive land of plenty, but in the Christ who died and rose again to save you for himself — the one who is your life, your pleasure, your milk and honey, your all. – Scott Hubbard
- ♣ God leads His children TO the wilderness and IN the wilderness. God reveals Himself in the desert. The wilderness is a place of preparation, not permanence. Lisa Appelo
- ♣ God intentionally leads his children into the wilderness. He didn't stop paying attention or let go of us. God led the Israelites into the wilderness. He led Elijah and David and Jacob into the wilderness. God also led Jesus into the wilderness. Lisa Appelo
- ♣ And where God leads, He also provides. When God led Israel into the desert, he gave them fresh manna every morning. God fed Elijah meat &bread thru ravens &provided safety &men for David. After Jesus fasted 40 days in the wilderness, God sent angels to care for him. Lisa Appelo
- ↓ It was in the wilderness that God revealed himself to Hagar & to the Hebrews as the Bread of Heaven. The Living Water. The Holy One. Law Giver. The Rock. And it was in the wilderness that God took Moses to the top of the mountain where he displayed his glory. Lisa Appelo
- ♣ Tho we're tempted to kick against the wilderness places, we can trust that God has led us there &will provide for us there. He will reveal himself in ways we'd never know otherwise &will use the wilderness to test us &prepare us for the end he already has in mind. – Lisa Appelo
- Sometimes GOD will let us be uncomfortable now, so He can bless us later on. He'll close a door we don't like it, we don't understand it -- but later on, He'll open up a bigger door, He'll take us to a new level of our destiny. Sharon Manlangit, CPA
- ♣ There are times GOD will stir things up: A friend will do you wrong, You lose a loved-one, Business goes down . . . GOD uses loss, betrayal, persecution to force us to change. God's pushing you into your purpose. – Sharon Manlangit, CPA
- ♣ Every closed door is not a bad thing. Every person that walks away is not a mistake. GOD knows we wouldn't go without a push. We may not like it, but if GOD had not closed those doors, we would be satisfied to stay where we were. Sharon Manlangit, CPA

- ♣ The problem of worrying about what others think of you... When we waste the gift of time worrying about what others think, we are distracted from our God given purpose. The enemy can't steal the light of Christ in us, but he can tempt us to hide it. - Sunshyne Gray
- ♣ Keep in mind, working for the approval of people is also an energy/time drain. Sunshyne Gray
- ♣ It's time to stop worrying about what others think of you. Fear of what others think will drain you of joy and peace. Stop striving for the approval of people. Sunshyne Gray
- Begin paying attention to the thoughts driving fear of what others think. Battle & challenge those thoughts rather than trying to decrease fear thru striving & working for the approval of people. God doesn't want you working that shift anymore. - Sunshyne Gray
- God has more for you restored peace and joy as you live less for man and more for him. -Sunshyne Gray
- ♣ When you find yourself sinking in the quicksand, there is little else you can do but cry to the Lord. Sometimes He allows the "quicksand" experiences to turn you to Him. Wait for God… — Warren W. Wiersbe
- ♣ ...Acknowledge that God is in control. Give Him the pieces of your broken heart and watch Him work for you. You can depend on His faithfulness. Warren W. Wiersbe
